Finances

The 2016 Financial Accounts are finally complete and copies together with the Audit Report are available to read in the Clubhouse (an electronic copy is available on request). The format and information now required by the Incorporated Societies and Charities Commission is somewhat different and more extensive than in previous years.

As was pointed out at the Annual General Meeting, grant funding is becoming harder and harder to access. The Club rarely receives 100% of the application and the balance has to be met from general funds and if this is not possible then the grant money is required to be returned. At present we have 4 applications waiting – Central Energy Trust, Trillian Trust, NZCT and Pub Charity. In addition the Manawatu District Council general & water rates remission applications will be due soon, this year the Club meets the criteria and if successful the remission will be for 3 years.

Machinery Replacement

The Board has recently decided that the Club will open a new bank account called the 'Machinery Replacement Account', which will receive all proceeds from the sale of firewood. The funds in this account will be used solely for the replacement of machinery and equipment used on the course. Much of the work involved in cutting up and splitting of the wood is being done by volunteers so the funds in this account will be tangible evidence of volunteers efforts. There is currently plenty of firewood available for sale so anyone interested should contact Glen or the Office. The Club is now a Registered Charitable Entity and donations made to the Club qualify for tax rebates. This means that a donation of \$1,000 would entitle the giver to a refund from the IRD of \$330. Any members who may be considering making a donation to the Club may request that it be paid specifically to the Machinery Replacement Account.

Golf Autoscore Scorecards – Reminder

Filling in scorecards for the Card Reader: (check in the Locker Rooms)

An **'up and down'** pen stroke please – not sideways or crossways.

Please use any coloured pen but red as the Reader will not detect it. Light pencil does not always read either – needs to be dark lines.

Completing cards - holes 9 & 18 are missed quite regularly. Take care not to damage or write on the red bar line across the top and the light pink area on the left.
