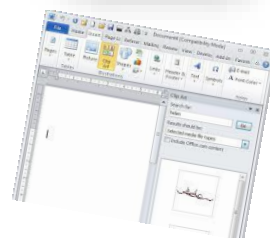

Oroua Schools



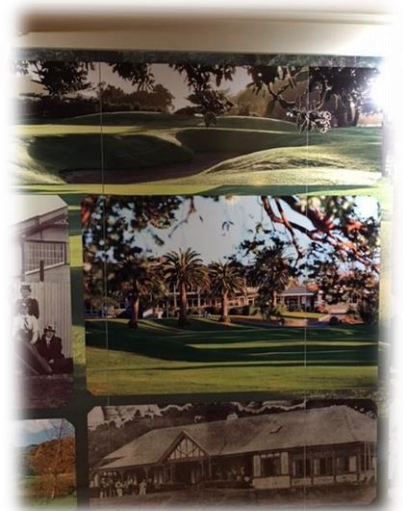

FootGolf Summer League @ Feilding Golf Club

Friday evenings could get a whole lot more social with Manawatu's brand new sport. Get your mates together & enter in our FootGolf League this summer. Teams will consist of 4 people each, playing Friday evenings starting @ 6pm.

The game is a combination of the popular sports of soccer & golf. The game format is identical to golf, except instead of using a golf ball & golf clubs, the players use a soccer ball & their leg. The game is played with a regulation #5 soccer ball at a golf course facility on shortened holes with 21-inch diameter cups. The rules largely correspond to the rules of golf.

When: Friday evenings @ 6pm

Starts: 3rd November 2017 – 15th December 2017

Restarts: 19th January 2018 – 2nd March 2018

Cost: \$32 registration fee & then \$8 fee per person each week.

* Supply your own #5 ball or hire for \$5 per round.

Location: Feilding Golf Club, Waughs Road, Feilding.

FootGolf Rules Highlights:

- FootGolf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for the other players & to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy & sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.
- Players should not play until the players in front are out of range. If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such a situation is "fore."
- On the teeing ground, a player should not tee his ball until it is his turn to play.
- Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole, when another player is about to play.
- You are not allowed to roll the ball or use the sole of the foot. On the putting green, players should not stand on another player's line of putt or when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt. Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the ground have holed out.

FootGolf Scoring:

- The goal is to play as few strokes (aka kicks) per round as possible.
