FootGolf Summer League @ Feilding Golf Club

Friday evenings could get a whole lot more social with Manawatu's brand new sport. Get your mates together and enter in our FootGolf League this summer.

Teams will consist of 4 people each, playing Friday evenings starting at 6pm.

All ages are welcome to play in our FootGolf league.

The game is a combination of soccer and golf. The game format is identical to golf, except instead of using a golf ball and golf clubs, the player's uses a soccer ball and their leg.

FootGolf is a combination of the popular sports of soccer and golf.

The game is played with a regulation #5 soccer ball at a golf course facility on shortened holes with 21-inch diameter cups.

The rules largely correspond to the rules of golf.

When: Friday evenings at 6pm

Starts: 3rd November 2017 – 15th December 2017

Restarts: 19th January 2018 – 2nd March 2018

Cost: \$32 registration fee and then \$8 fee per person each week.*

Location: Feilding Golf Club, Waughs Road, Feilding.

Cost* discounted to \$400 per team for a season discount, if paid in one lump sum prior to league start date. Cost to hire a ball \$5 per round or you supply your own #5 ball.



FootGolf Rules Highlights:

- FootGolf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

- Players should not play until the players in front are out of range. If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such a situation is "fore."

- On the teeing ground, a player should not tee the ball until it is their turn to play.

- Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole, when another player is about to play.

- You are not allowed to roll the ball or use the sole of the foot. On the putting green, players should not stand on another player's line of putt or when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt. Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the group have holed out.

FootGolf Scoring:

- The goal is to play as few strokes (aka kicks) per round as possible.
