## Women's Denbigh Cup & Spring Tournament



The 2018 Women's Denbigh Cup & Spring Tournament was jointly won by Feilding's Shirley Frederickson and Marton's Bronwyn Bielby with a Nett 65 each. A great round, girls!

A little on the Denbigh Cup history.....The cup was presented by Mr George Clarke of the Denbigh Hotel in 1950 and was first competed for in that year. The annual 1-day tournament was changed to a 2-day tournament - match play. From 1951 to 1960 the tournament was extended to 3 days with the first 36 holes being a qualifying round and the Denbigh Cup was awarded to the top qualifier. From 1957 to 1960 Mr & Mrs Ivan Neal of the Denbigh Hotel donated a trophy each year to go with the cup. A number of the visiting competitors used to stay at the Hotel. In 1960 due to numbers not as great, the tournament was changed to a 2 day. In 1972 it became a 1-day tournament, competition 36 hole nett and for some time was still played in that format, however, it is now played over just 18 holes. Mr Clarke had given his permission for the Cup to be used for any event the Committee wished.
