

#### JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Feilding Golf Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, officials, administrators', parents and spectators associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, all those associated with Feilding Golf Club should comply with these Codes of Conduct.

## JUNIORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play for the fun of it not just to please your parents or coaches.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Listen to your coaches at all times to ensure the safety of all present.
- Children under 14 years of age must have a parent or guardian present at all times during coaching sessions and when playing the course. We have restricted membership options available for parents wishing to play with their children.

## COACHING INFORMATION & PLAYING ON THE COURSE

- Junior Coaching is available during the school term every Sunday from 9:30am 10:30am.
- All players without a handicap must play off the purple tees and play "ít's okay rules" (see copy of "It's okay rules" attached).
- Once the player is able to score less than 70 for 9 holes, they can progress to removing "It's okay rules" and begin submitting scorecards to gain a handicap continuing to play off the purple tees.
- Once the player can score under 50 on the purple tees for 9 holes, they can progress to the red tees.
- Players must book in to play the course by calling the Golf Shop.
- Consequences for unwelcome or inappropriate behaviour:
  - o 1st instance parents to be spoken to
  - o 2nd instance child to be stood down for 2 sessions
  - o 3rd instance removal from program for the term

## PARENT / GUARDIAN / SUPPORTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Encourage children to participate if they are interested. If they are not, don't force them. Remember children are involved in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Focus on the child's effort and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event.

- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results. Applaud good play by all participants.
- Teach your child that honest effort is as important as winning, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with or in the vicinity of persons Under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities and avoid use of derogatory language based on gender, race or impairment.
- Encourage and guide juniors to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
